3. Alpha Progress

- Commission activities: cooking is fine at this scale, need more resources, and reimbursement for larger and multiple groups. Need additional resources for hosts—bring in evangelical team. Dawn to contact spiritual directors to be facilitators for small (discussion) groups (try to keep to 8-12 participants each.)
- Next steps? Dawn to set up review of other parishes using Alpha to evaluate strengths and weaknesses. (Check Simon content for other models for evaluation?) See above, plus roll out new seminars by Feb 1, starting with invitation at all masses, try to split into two groups, one using the "traditional" tapes and one using the tapes targeting younger participants. Perhaps offer a lunch-time option especially for HF staff.

4. 2018 Congress (March 13-18)

 Prior year's activities cross referenced to activities, responsibilities and schedule for 2018 (by item)

- i. What is schedule for program availability and registration dates? Programs are out now—deadline for registration at \$70 (before it goes up to \$80) is January 26. And as a result, what is the schedule for our table in the gathering area? January 7, January 21 (reserved by Dawn) (skip 1/14 due to MLK holiday, 1/28 is Catholic Schools Week.)

- iv. Mentoring list considering prior attendees to us from DRE (date?—*Ginny to facilitate*)—<u>when</u> can Commission members try to match these "targets" to the right strategy for recruiting them to be a mentor, and then matching them to a candidate? (TBD)
