Minutes: The minutes from the January 12, 2016 were approved.

PLD/Parish Update: Cambria Tortorelli reported the Security Enhancement project is going forward. David Law is getting bids from contractors for the work. On March 28, 2016 the Planning Committee will meet to review the issues pertaining to the school and the Specific Plan.

Planning/Visioning/Administration Report from Hayden Claisse: Ed Panconi presented the report. The planning process has been completed and the priorities have been identified. The next step to this process of Planning/Visioning/ Administration will be to work on achieving the priorities. The priorities were identified through the SWOT analysis (reported in previous minutes). Ed also discussed how we can develop a stronger relationship between Commission Leaders and the individual ministries they represent. Each ministry should have a representative attend the Commission meetings and a Commission member should attend one of the ministry meetings. Ed also discussed what can be done to attract parishioners to become Commission members, Pastoral Council member, or Finance Council members. A Leadership Information Night will be held **April 6, 2016** inviting all parish members to attend to recruit new members.

Community Life Report: Mary Schimmoller reported that there will be 2 "Gift Gathering Parties" to procure donations and items for the upcoming auction in April. Those parties will be held on March 5, 2016 and March 19, 2016. There will be a table at the Continental Breakfast to welcome new parishioners on the last Sunday of the month. Adult Bingo Night is scheduled for May 13, 2016. On July 9, 2016 "Parish Movie Night" will be in the hall. The movie is "Star Wars". Attendees will be asked to dress as one of the characters if they so wish.

Education/Formation Report: Candy Krueger reported that Michael Fish will be speaking next month at Holy Family. This is a 4 session retreat and seats are limited. Parishioners are asked to register early to insure a seat. There will be 200 seats available.

School Report: Anne Murphy reported that the Holy Family students were invited to the first South Pasadena Prayer Breakfast. Michael Downing gave a fantastic lecture on ISIS, which was extremely informative. The school choir sang 2 songs at the breakfast.
