## Overview (Please read this information)

- 1. We will meet for ten Thursdays for about two hours. If you are present for 75% of the session, you receive full credit. If not, please do the makeup on Edmodo.

- f. What is a covenant?
- g. In this drama, why did the Trinity decide to go to earth even though they could see the consequences of Chris (Jesus) becoming the messiah?
- h. What does "Vaya con Dios" mean?
