



Gospel Glossary

Rabbi is a Jewish scholar or teacher **Transfigured** means to turn into something more beautiful or elevated. Moses, and one for Elijah." He hardly knew what to say, they were so terrified. Then a cloud came, casting a shadow over them; from the cloud came a voice, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." Suddenly, looking around, they no longer saw anyone but lesus alone with them. As they were coming down from the mountain, he charged them not to relate what they had seen to anyone, except when the Son of Man had risen from the dead. So they kept the matter to themselves. questioning what rising from the dead meant.
