Catechizing Corner!

Today begins the season of Ordinary Time. At the beginning of the new liturgical cycle, the focus is on the beginning of Jesus’ ministry. Thus the opening scene in today’s gospel begins the Sundays in Ordinary Time with John and two of his disciples in Bethany. John sees Jesus walk by and professes him as the “Lamb of God.” Peter and Andrew thus begin to follow Jesus, who simply extends the invitation, “Come and See.” Similarly, today’s first reading from Samuel foreshadows the Gospel with the story of Samuel, who was also called by God and subsequently responded in obedience.

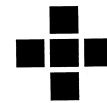

stayed with him that day. It was about four in the afternoon.

Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, was one of the two who heard John and followed Jesus. He first found his own brother Simon and told him, "We have found the Messiah" – which is translated Christ. Then he brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon the son of John; you will be called Cephas" – which is translated Peter.
