

The Easter season is not a time for giving an historical representation of the chronology of events in Jesus' post-resurrection life. It is rather, intended to give sufficient time to uncover, unpack and reflect on the paschal mystery in order to allow all of its dimensions to impact and affect the Christian life.

Call to Prayer

Begin by calling upon God: In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.

Let us pause for a moment and listen attentively to this week's passage.

The Word of God John 20:1-9

A reading from the holy Gospel according to John:

On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and told them, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him." So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. They both ran, but the other disciple ran faster

than Peter and arrived at the tomb first; he bent down and saw the burial cloths there, but did not go in. When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.

Burial Cloths are - one or more pieces of cloth used to wrap a deceased person. A **Tomb** is a large vault used for burying the dead. **Scripture** means the sacred writings of a religion.
