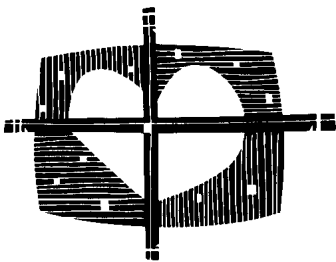

Catechizing Corner!

The New Testament gives us three different narratives of the ascension of Christ that describe Jesus' final withdrawal of his physical presence from his disciples. The ascension is an expression of Jesus' risen state that celebrates his victory and points toward Pentecost and the second coming.

Jesus is understood as the Lord of the universe. The ascension reveals Jesus' status as Lord and Christ. Since he ascended in heaven, he demonstrated control over the created order of the universe. Thus, Jesus is its master.

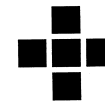

Call to Prayer

Begin by calling upon God: In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.

Let us pause for a moment and listen attentively to this week's passage.

The Word of God Mark 16:15-20

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark:

Jesus said to his disciples:

“Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature.

Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved;

whoever does not believe will be condemned.

These signs will accompany those who believe:

in my name they will drive out demons,

To Proclaim is to declare something publicly. In the bible, **demons** are fallen angels and the opposite of good angels. Biblical **Signs** confirm divine directions.

they will speak new languages. They will pick up serpents with their hands, and if they drink any deadly thing, it will not harm them. They will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.” So then the Lord Jesus, after he spoke to them, was taken up into heaven and took his seat at the right hand of God. But they went forth and preached everywhere, while the Lord worked with them and confirmed the word through accompanying signs.
