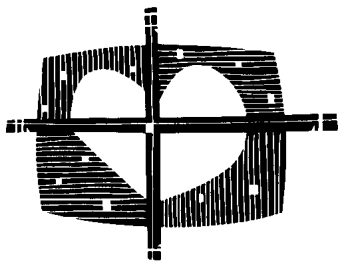

Trinity Sunday is one of our four solemnities of the Lord during ordinary time. Since these feasts are dependent upon the celebration of Easter, they are called movable solemnities of ordinary time. The solemnities are Trinity Sunday, Corpus Christy, Sacred Heart, and Christ the King. The Most Holy Trinity is celebrated on the first Sunday after Pentecost and if we were to say that there is a bottom line in this liturgy, it can be summed up as: Blessed be God the Father and his only begotten Son and the Holy Spirit; for he has shown that he loves us.

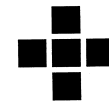
