- It was noted that past Chairs who were also school parents were particularly effective in gaining support from school communities.

Current Needs and Reminders:

- Annual guideline forms need to be signed by all involved. Marie Lopez retains the signed forms for school staff and school families; Patricia maintains the records for parish staff.
- Patricia will investigate whether there is a formal job description for the Safeguard Committee Chair.

Action Items:

- Work on bringing all liturgical ministers into full compliance with safeguard requirements.
- Fr. Ricky will follow up with Julio Herrera regarding the status of usher training and documentation.
